Effective **6/15/2007**, APUS entered into a Cooperative Program with Air University called the Associate to Baccalaureate Cooperative Program (AU-ABC) for the completion of a specific CCAF AAS Degree.

Total credit transferred toward a Bachelor's Degree cannot exceed 90 SH.

This Cooperative Program allows for a **MINIMUM of 61** SH, assuming ALL AAS DEGREE requirements from the institution have been completed. Other college credit from different sources will be reviewed on a course-by-course basis.

- Students must submit an **official CCAF Transcript** with specific **AAS DEGREE AWARDED** along with other required admission documents.
- Students must email [articulations@apus.edu](mailto:articulations@apus.edu) and let us know they may qualify for an AU-ABC program evaluation.

Airmen with qualifying CCAF degrees are guaranteed to complete their bachelor's degree in 60 semester hours or less with APUS and will receive a **MINIMUM of 61** semester hours total transfer credits toward the APUS Bachelor's Degree. Of these credits:

- a minimum of 12 SH will be applied to the General Education area
- a minimum of 9 SH will be applied to the Core or Major area
- all other credit will be applied according to standard policy
- a maximum of 60 SH will remain for completion of the Bachelor's Degree

**Please Note:** Specific details and remaining course requirements will vary per student; and will be detailed in the students Academic Plan once an official Transfer Credit Evaluation (TCE) is completed.
